500 North to 1300 South

UDOT to Resurface Heber Main Street to Preserve Roadway

Beginning July 5, 2017, and continuing through late-August 2017, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will resurface U.S. Highway 40 (Heber Main Street) from 500 North to Gateway Drive.

For the first phase of the project, crews will work on utility accesses (manholes) and sidewalk ramps. Travel delays should be light.

Night time Travel Delays

After the Pioneer Day Holiday (July 24), crews are scheduled to repave the road at night. Crews will reduce Main Street to one lane in each direction between **7 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. Motorists should anticipate moderate travel delays and use alternate routes where possible. Please slow down when driving through construction zones and watch out for crews working within the area.

Area residents should expect noise and some vibration due to crews operating heavy construction equipment during work hours.
