The Heber City Police Department in cooperation with Wasatch County Emergency Management, and the Wasatch County Citizen Corps Council will be hosting a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training class starting in September 2017. CERT training provides knowledge of what to do in an emergency or disaster to help yourself and others in your neighborhood, including topics such as: light fire suppression, first aid, light search and rescue and many other topics.
